



# **NO** -risk Guarantee

Morris Press Cookbooks guarantees to every organization using our cookbook program that sales from the books will be sufficient to pay the printing bill in full. Guarantee is subject to these conditions:

1. Your organization does not sell the books for less than we suggest.
2. A 200 book order will contain recipes from at least 50 different individuals.
3. A 201-500 book order will contain recipes from at least 150 different individuals.
4. A 501-1000 book order will contain recipes from at least 200 different individuals.
5. A 1001-1500 book order will contain recipes from at least 250 different individuals.
6. A 1501-2000 book order will contain recipes from at least 300 different individuals.
7. A 2001-4000 book order will contain recipes from at least 400 different individuals.
8. A 4001-5000 book order will contain recipes from at least 500 different individuals.
9. Recipe contributors must be adults (potential buyers) and their names must be printed with their recipes.
10. If there is a balance which cannot be paid, then furnish proof to Morris Press Cookbooks that not enough cookbooks could be sold to pay for the order.

If these conditions are met and not enough cookbooks have been sold to pay the printing bill, the organization may return unsold books to Morris Press Cookbooks. In this event, all money collected from cookbook sales must be remitted to Morris Press Cookbooks. Authorization is required before returning any cookbooks.
